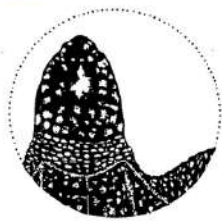

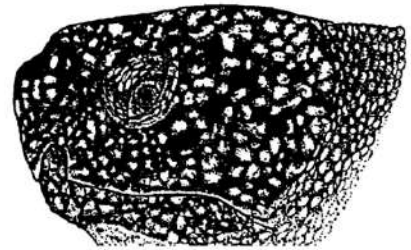

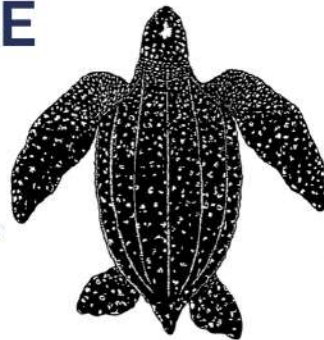


NO SCALES, THEY
HAVE A **PINK SPOT**

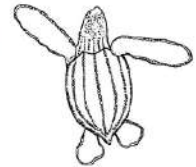


- **CARAPACE**

CARAPACE LENGTH:
ADULTS > 100cm
JUVENILES < 70cm
