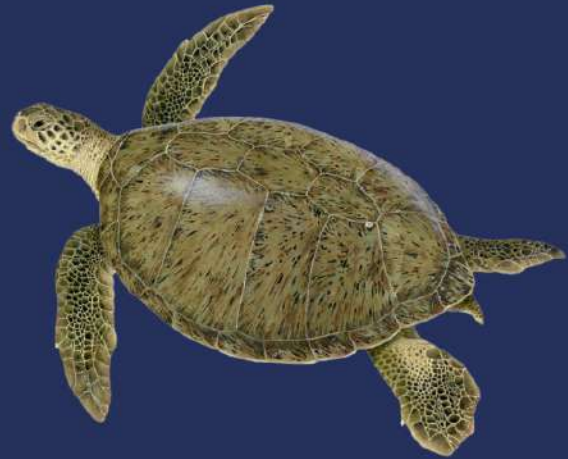

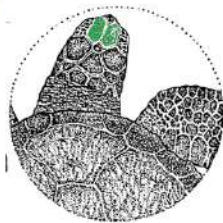

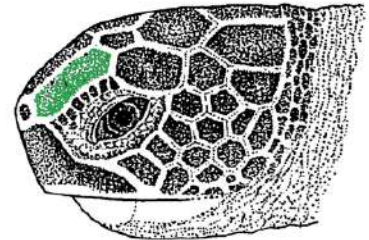

BETWEEN THE EYES**



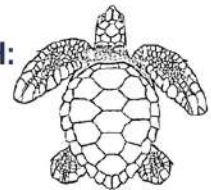
• CARAPACE

-  5 CENTRAL SCUTES
-  4 LATERAL SCUTES



CARAPACE LENGTH:
ADULTS > 80cm
JUVENILES < 50cm
