

CODE OF CONDUCT



FOR DIVERS AND SNORKELERS

If you meet a marine turtle during your diving / snorkeling trip, remember:



NEVER TOUCH A TURTLE



NEVER FEED A TURTLE



KEEP A SLOW PACE AND KEEP AT LEAST 2-3 m DISTANCE



ONLY APPROACH THEM SLOWLY FROM BEHIND OR FROM ONE SIDE IF YOU HAVE TO, SWIMMING PARALLEL TO THE ANIMAL



DO NOT SWIM DIRECTLY ABOVE A TURTLE AS THIS COULD INHIBIT THE TURTLE'S ABILITY TO SURFACE AND BREATHE



IF THE TURTLE IS MOVING AWAY, LET IT GO!
