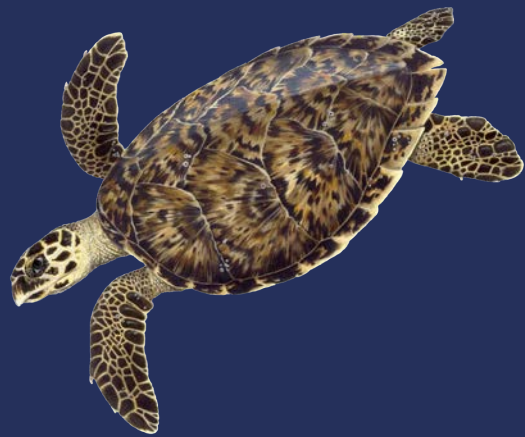

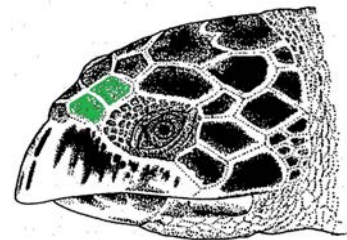
HOW TO IDENTIFY:

BETWEEN THE EYES

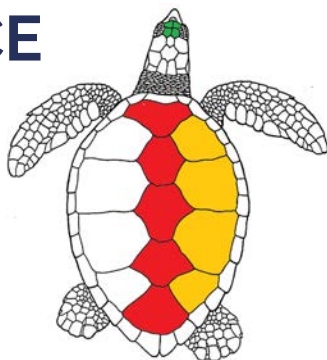


• CARAPACE

5 CENTRAL SCUTES

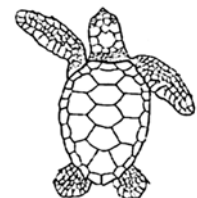
4 LATERAL SCUTES



CARAPACE LENGTH:

ADULTS > 70cm

JUVENILES < 50cm
